

# Making Inferences

The author doesn't always state everything that happens in a story.

Sometimes we have to look **at clues from the text (passage)** and **think of what we already know** to get a better picture of what is happening. We call this making **inferences**.

When you're reading you can use clues from the text and what you already know to figure out things that the author *didn't* tell you.
